Navigation (Beginning & Advanced): This course is for the person that wants to learn how to navigate and not just using a GPS. **It requires no previous knowledge.** The first three weeks brings all the students to the same level of basic navigation. The rest of the course covers Piloting, Electronic Navigation, DR Tracks, Lines of position, Advancing Lines of position, Tide & Current predictions, Radar use – CPA and determining the other vessels course & speed – sextant use. **Class Meet Mondays only 7:15 PM to 9:30 PM for 17 weeks Cost: \$160 per person Texts, workbook & charts are included (First 3 weeks \$45 ~ rest of the course \$115)**

The Power & Sail classes meet the requirement for the State of RI Boating Certificate that is required for Boat operators born after 1 June 1986 or any PWC operators.
